The upper right image shows the diversity of tree types and highlights 'dead tops'. Even the dead trees play a crucial role in monitoring the forests health. Now to the bottom image; tree's that measure above a certain diameter receive this metal tag. The tags are placed facing south, with room to grow. The trees species, diameter, and livlieness are recorded to reference.
