Eugene Smith was a member of the Class of 1922 at Westbrook Seminary. While attending Westbrook, he was a member of the baseball, track, and football teams. He also served on the editorial board for Messenger and assisted with the planning of sporting events. While a student, Eugene was a member of the U.S. Naval Reserves, receiving his draft letter in February 1921 from the Consul General in Havana, Cuba. In 1945, he was stationed in Honolulu, Hawaii, and served as a crewmember of the U.S.S. O'Flaherty.

Scope and Contents

Within Eugene Smith's scrapbook are items and notes about student life at Westbrook Seminary. This includes ephemera from school events and materials relating to athletics at Westbrook, including contracts, rosters, and team schedules. The scrapbook also includes class notes which contain signatures, addresses, and personal notes of members of the Class of 1922.

Doris Rousseau was a student at Westbrook Junior College during 1943-45 and enrolled in the Medical Secretary program. She was the daughter of Ovide and Yvonne (Binette) Rousseau but was later adopted by Walter and Alice Blake. Before beginning Westbrook, Rousseau resided in Lewiston, Maine until moving to Sanford, Maine in 1942. She was a graduate of Sanford High's class of 1943. While in college she was the president of the Bell House, manager of the Glee Club, secretary of the Athletic Association, and member of the Student Christian Association. Additionally, she participated in the Masque and Candle Dramatic Club, where she was a member of the scenery committee and the field hockey team and Ski Club. During this time, she received several awards, most notably the Dean's Award in music for her contributions to the musical and dramatic arts program at Westbrook. After graduating from Westbrook in 1945, Doris Rousseau accepted a position as an assistant to Dr. Owen B. Head who practiced in Sanford, Maine.

Scope and Contents

This scrapbook contains materials relating to student life at Westbrook. Primarily, it consists of newspaper clippings regarding on-campus activities, weddings, and athletic events. Also included are personal items and ephemera such as graduation cards, class schedules, and notes. There are photographs and newsletters about alumni reunions.

During her time at Westbrook, she served as housemother of Goddard Hall (1946-50), Johnson Hall (1950-51), and Melville Hall (1952- 56). Additionally, she served as the Chair of the Department of Literature and Language from 1954 to 1966. Following the

establishment of the Maine Women's Writer Collection in 1959, Dow served as the curator. While at Westbrook she participated in student activities such as the Blue Stocking, in which she held the role of both Founder and Editor.

Scope and Contents

Within this scrapbook are items relating to the career and retirement of Grace Dow. Primarily, it is made up of letters of recognition written by faculty, alumni, and students of Westbrook and other institutions. These letters specifically highlight the accomplishments and attributes of Grace Dow throughout her career. In this collection are images of Grace Dow handling items from the Maine Women's Writers Collection and interacting with students.
