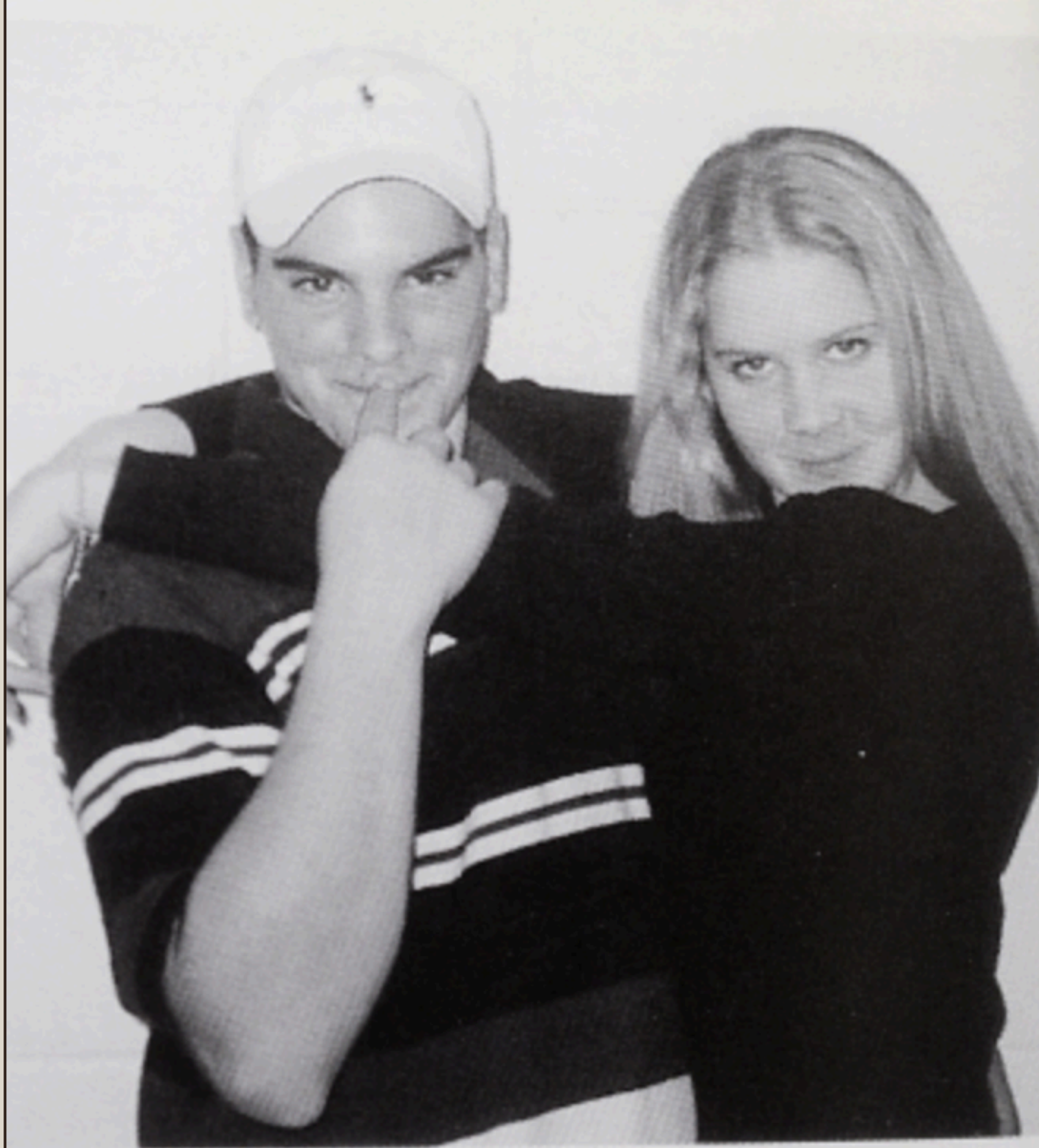

CHILDHOOD

Who Is Amy Schumer?

- Born June 1, 1981 in NYC, Manhattan Upper East Side
- Grew up with an alcoholic father and a mother who struggled to support her
- Moved to Long Island, New York after her father developed multiple sclerosis
- Had multiple abusive relationships during her late teen years and early twenties
- Graduated from South Side High School with the titles "Class Comedian" and "Teacher's Worst Nightmare"
- Graduated from Towson University with a Theater degree in 2003

CAREER *KICKOFF*

- 2007 Amy appeared as a contestant on NBC's *Last Comic Standing*, elevating her profile
- 2010 she headlined the hit series, *Comedy Central Presents (CCP)*
- Her success on *CCP* and the producers greenlighted the creation of her own show *Inside Amy Schumer* (2013)

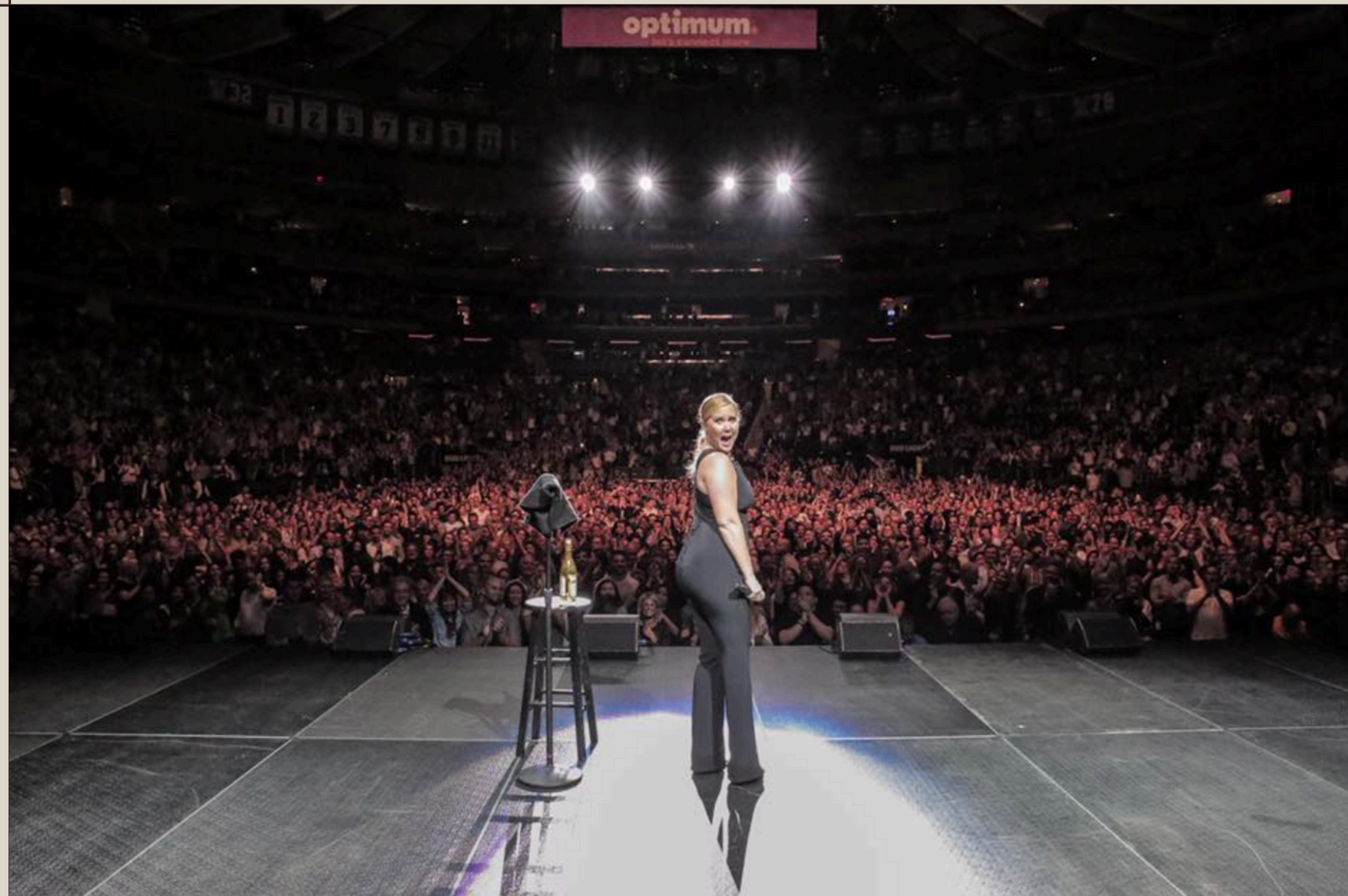

In 2016 Amy made history as the first female stand-up comic to sell out Madison Square Garden.

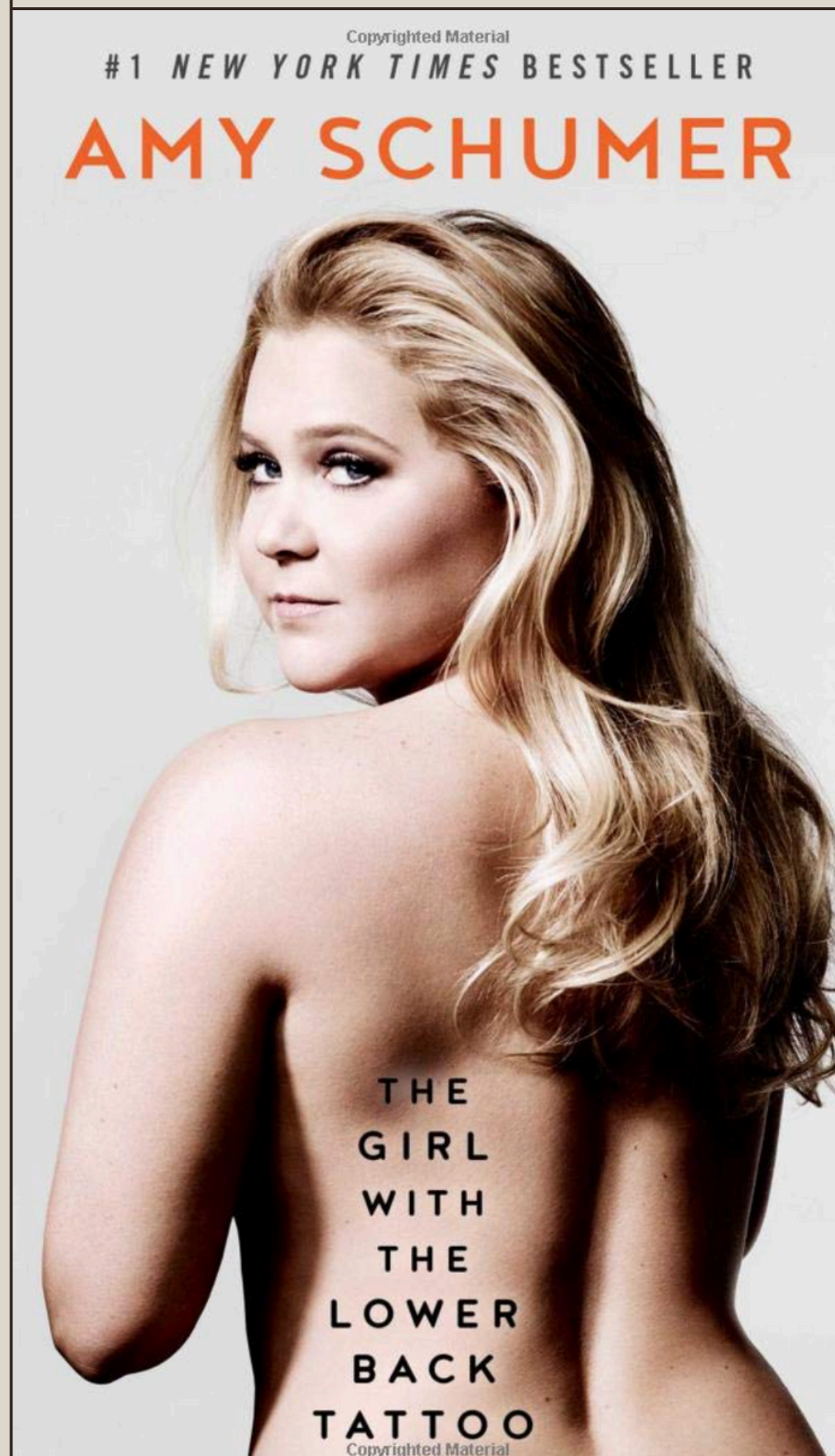

Trainwreck (2015)

Amy Schumer debuts as lead character, "Amy" in her autobiographical comedy, earning a Golden Globe nomination for Best Actress in a Motion Picture Comedy or Musical.

MESSAGE: love, commitment, and personal growth are not weaknesses.



I Feel Pretty (2018)

"You ask 'What's the sexiest thing?' 'Confidence!' But do we ever really see an example of that? That's what the movie is all about." - Amy Schumer on I Feel Pretty with Refinery29.

MESSAGE: self-confidence and self-love being so much more important than what you look like.



Meteor Shower (2017)

Shaken and stirred: Amy Schumer serves up comedy in Steve Martin's, *Meteor Shower* - Amy's Broadway debut.

MESSAGE: the vulnerability of marriage.



Life & Beth (2022)

Autobiographical series by Amy Schumer on topics of mental health, grief, mortality, and relationships - trauma from her teenage years.

MESSAGE: the journey of self-discovery, healing from past trauma, and finding authentic happiness by confronting one's past and embracing change can be difficult, but worthwhile.
